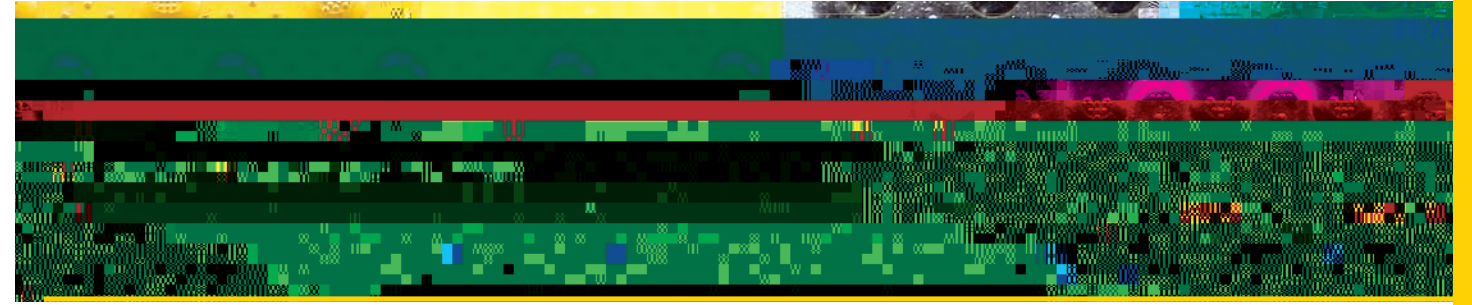
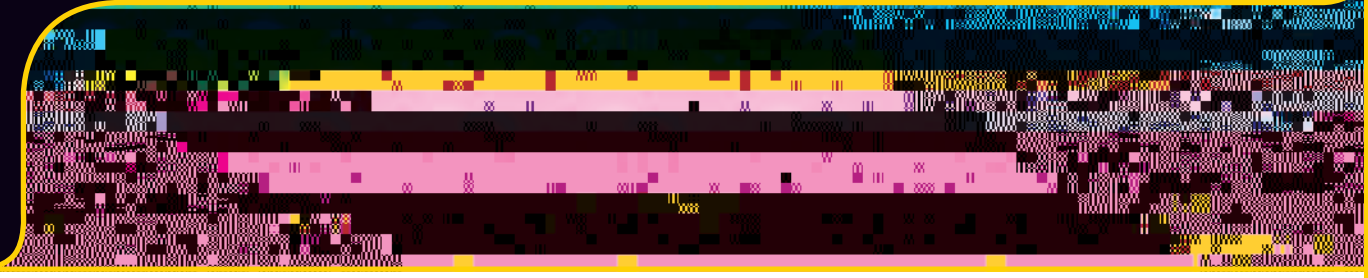


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Barton School faculty members are well known for their cutting edge practitioner based research. Barton School faculty also conduct research on how business school can be more effective in teaching
