I was made aware of thes allegations and the review process on Thursday, Octoberd I then requested the Faculty SenatExecutive Committee review the application of the University Misconduct in Researc Policy (9.13) to this matter and the recommend appropriate follow-up actions The Faculty SenatExecutive Committee consists of 8 faculty membres from 7 academic divisions across campus They represented the tenure-track and NTT faculty.

On Friday, Octobre 11th, the executive committee met to conduct a review of the application of Policy 9.13 to these matters. The meeting opened and warmmediately called into an executive session. The committee was provided with the reports from the internal misconduct inquiry and the external reviews. The committee data spoke with Provos Lefever and President Muma about the review process.

The committee unanimous/ found that the University Misconductin Research Policy (9.13) was appropriately and fairly applied in this matter following proces afforded to al WSU faculty. The committee is recommending no furthmetic related this matter.
