Assistantships and Fellowships are awarded primarily on the basis of a student's academic record, potential as a degree candidate, teaching, or research, activities. Applicants must be formally admitted to a graduate degree program at Wichita State. Students admitted on probation or placed on academic probation following admission are not eligible for such awards.

Assistantships provide cash stipends and may include tuition assessment at resident rates. Students awarded a Graduate Teaching Assistantship may qualify for up to 100% waiver of their tuition.

The actual dollar amount of an assistantship varies according to the length of the appointment, the number of hours worked per week, and the funding base within each program area. At Wichita State, assistantships for twenty hours of work per week, for a nine-month period, range from \$5,000 to \$12,000.

Fellowship selections are made on a competitive basis without regard to race, creed, gender, or national origin. The individual program area determines determines the award amounts.

## Major Responsibilities of Assistantships Defined

- A Graduate Teaching Assistant (GTA) either directs instruction or assists with instruction. Appointment as a GTA requires that non-native speakers of English attain a minimum score of 50 on the Test of Spoken English.
- A Graduate Research Assistant (GRA) assists faculty with their scholarly research and creative abilities.
- A Graduate Staff Assistant (GSA) assists university service and academic units in either non teaching or non-research activities.
