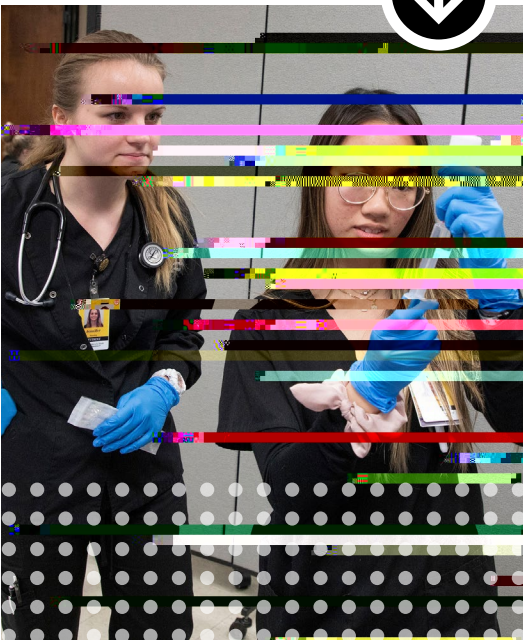
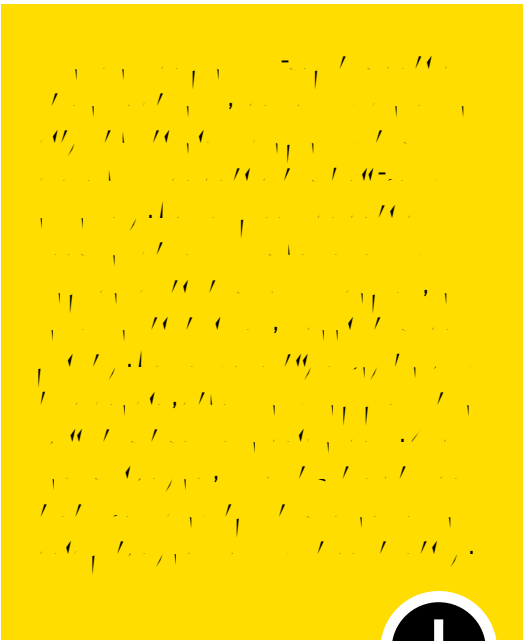

ADMISSION INTO OUR PRE-LICENSURE PROGRAMS IS COMPETITIVE

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (BSN) IN NURSING PROGRAM

The Bachelor of Science in Nursing program at WSU is a four-year program that prepares students for entry-level nursing practice. The program includes coursework in nursing theory, clinical practice, and research. Students who complete the program will be eligible to sit for the NCLEX-RN exam and become registered nurses.

TRADITIONAL BSN PROGRAM:

Students who enter the program as first-year students will complete the program in four years. The program includes coursework in nursing theory, clinical practice, and research. Students who complete the program will be eligible to sit for the NCLEX-RN exam and become registered nurses.

EARLY ADMISSIONS BSN:

Students who enter the program as first-year students and complete the program in three years. The program includes coursework in nursing theory, clinical practice, and research. Students who complete the program will be eligible to sit for the NCLEX-RN exam and become registered nurses.

ACCELERATED BSN:

Students who enter the program as first-year students and complete the program in two years. The program includes coursework in nursing theory, clinical practice, and research. Students who complete the program will be eligible to sit for the NCLEX-RN exam and become registered nurses.

MINIMUM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 in all college coursework. Students must have completed the following coursework with a minimum grade of C-:
